

Butcher-Greene Surpasses GAP Food Donation Goal

Congratulations to the students, staff and family members of Butcher-Greene Elementary School for collecting 1,550 food donation items to benefit the Grandview Assistance Program (GAP) during the week of September 19-23. This amount was well past their original goal of 923 items. The top two collecting classrooms were Ms. Suienniks's (357 items) and Mrs. Norton's (191 items).

GAP has provided emergency assistance to Grandview C-4 School District and City of Grandview families for basic needs since 1992. At this time GAP is critically low on their stock of can and dry food donation items. Donations are needed throughout the year. Non-perishable food items can be dropped off at the GAP office
