Jalin Brown (SS) signing with the Lindenwood University Football Team

Jalin is a three year starter for the bulldog defense. He earned 2nd team all conference honors this past season at Strong Safety. He had 55 tackles, 1 interception and one forced fumble his senior year. He is also a stand out sprinter on Grandview's State Championship track team. Jalin carries a 3.3 GPA and scored a 21 on the ACT test. Jalin is planning on majoring in graphic design while at Lindenwood.

Jaron Alexander (WR) signing with the Lindenwood University Football Team

Jaron is a 2 year starter for the bulldogs. He was a unanimous 1st team all conference player, 2nd team all state selection and a finalist for the Otis Taylor - most outstanding wide receiver award. Jaron had 1117 yards receiving and 16 touchdowns his senior season on offense; he also had 30 tackles and one forced fumble while playing on the defensive side of the ball. Jaron broke school records for both yards in a season (previously held by Nebraska's Brandon Kinnie) and career yards (previously held by Kansas State's Rimmon McNeese). Jaron also is a valuable member of the state championship track team, scoring 12 points and bringing home 3 silver medals at the state meet in the open 100, 4x100 meter relay and the 4x200 meter relay. Jaron carries a 3.5 GPA and scored a 24 on the ACT test. Jaron will major in computer information systems while attending Lindenwood.

Christian Drummer (DL) signing with the Chadron State University Football Team

Christian is a 2 year starter for the bulldogs, he was selected 2nd team all conference and 3rd team all state defensive line. He was the team leader in defensive points, led the team in sacks (13) and tackles for loss (21). He also had 66 total tackles, 2 forced fumbles and one fumble recovery. He scored a 23 on the ACT test and is planning on becoming a pre-med major at Chadron.

Zane More signing with the Chadron State University Football Team

Zane is a 1st year starter for the bulldogs due to missing his junior season because of transfer regulations. He was extremely productive in his one year playing both sides of the football; as a tight end on offense and defensive end on defense. He was selected to the all conference team as 2nd team athlete. Zane had 22 tackles, 6 tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks, and 19 receptions for 306 yards on offense. He also was a pivotal blocker in the run game for the offense. Zane scored a 20 on the ACT and is planning on majoring in business while at Chadron.

Dapo Akinmoladun signing with the University of Nebraska Track Team

Dapo dominated the track during his junior season winning Gold at the KU Relays in both the 110 meter high hurdles and the 300 meter intermediate hurdles. He is also the 2011 state champion in the 300 meter hurdles and silver medalist in the 110 hurdles. He posted times of 14.12 seconds in the 110 meter hurdles and 38.53 in the 300 meter hurdles. He played a critical role on the relay teams as well. Dapo scored 20 points at the state meet last spring which pushed the team towards the state championship. Dapo currently has a 3.8 GPA and scored a 24 on the ACT test. He will be a pre-med major while attending Nebraska.
