

## CADET TEACHING OVERVIEW

### I. CAREER AWARENESS

GOAL: To work with elementary/middle school mentor teacher and students individually and as a class.

ASSESSMENT: The students' evaluation will be determined by the mentor teacher's observation of the cadet working with the students.

OBJECTIVE:

a. The learner will be working with the students as the mentor teacher directs.

GOAL: The cadet will develop and teach at least one complete lesson each semester.

ASSESSMENT: The students' performance will be determined by assessment of whether the goals of the lesson were achieved.

OBJECTIVE:

a. The learner will develop an objective, procedures, preparation and materials needed, and the evaluation to understand the lesson plan format.

GOAL: To write about daily cadet teaching experiences in a journal.

ASSESSMENT: The cadet's performance will be measured by the completion of these journals in the required time.

OBJECTIVE:

The learner will prepare a daily journal of the activities in the classroom.

GOAL: To write a paper on "Future Trends in Education".

ASSESSMENT: The cadet's performance will be measured by the preparation of the research paper project.

OBJECTIVE:

a. The cadet will create a research paper to determine the future trends in education.

GOAL: To develop skills required of a teacher.

ASSESSMENT: The cadet's performance will be measured in the completion of the selected projects.

OBJECTIVE:

a. The learner will learn the use of the copy machine, laminating machine, prepare a bulletin board project, and do a presentation on the teamboard.

GOAL: To develop leadership skills.

ASSESSMENT: The cadet's performance will be measured by activities in FTA activities and projects, other organizations in the school, and class participation at the elementary/middle schools and at GHS.

OBJECTIVE:

a. The learner will develop leadership skills by participation in presentations in the classroom.
